- 3. Today we have digital Bibles. No matter what form we read it in, it must be remembered and hidden in our hearts so we don't forget what it says.
- 4. Get all you can; read it, listen to it, listen to Bible teaching, etc. Hide it in your heart!
- 5. Let's pray for the torn Bible to be restored to the Princess and that we will start hiding God's Word in our heart!

CRAFT 3 - BIBLE THUMPERS

"Your word have I hid in my heart that I might not sin against you." Psl. 119:11

Precut all character parts(body, arms, face, etc) using the template sheet. Allow kids to glue parts together and add the eyes to create the star wars character.

Hot glue the mini Bible(backside only) on the area were hands would be; allowing the Bible to still open while attached to Bible Thumper character.

A magnet can be adhered to the back of Thumper so it can stick to the fridge. (optional)

- Supplies:Craft foam sheets or felt panels.
- Google eyes
- Glue
- Hot glue
- Mini bibles
- Magnets, optional





Mini Bibles can be purchased on Oriental Trading or most novelty toy websites. This particular one is a key chain which can be removed if not needed.

GAME 3

EWOK RESCUE:

Throwing stuff at targets is always fun.... except when your not facing the target.... then it's funner!

Surely you can gather a bunch of teddy bears from people in the church and at thrift store yard sales, for this one.

Supplies:

- A bunch of teddy bears; small to medium size.
- 1-3 good sized laundry baskets or any comparable container. Old wood crates would actually be more fitting, these represent the Ewoks tree house.
- Open floor with taped off launching line.
- Fica plants, fake ferns, anything to clutter the target area to make it look "woodsy"

- 2 or more teams.

Objective:

Toss your Ewok into the Forest of Endor and hope they land in their tree house(laundry basket) to save them.... oh, toss them over your shoulder while facing opposite of the

Set the Forest: Place several fake shrubs in a good sized area.


The baskets represent the Ewoks tree house. Add your baskets within the forest. Tape a print out sheet with a point value in each basket, if desired. Make the higher value point baskets a little more challenging by placing closer or partially behind a shrub. You can also set a basket atop a pedestal or chair for elevation.

Tape your launching line. Make 2 lines if desired; closer to forest for smaller kids, vice versa for big kids.

Play music in background throughout entire session but not so loud as to drown out telling the rules.

Rules:

- Determine how many kids from each team will play per round, this can be determined by how many Ewoks dolls you have (the more Ewoks, the more kids can play per round).
- Each kid gets an Ewok. All face opposite of Forest on the taped line.
- Countdown then all kids toss the Ewok over their shoulder into the Forest attempting to make sure the Ewok lands in a Tree House.
- Tally the point values from how many Ewoks made it home.
- Prepare next round of kids from opposite team. Play again.



ACT III- SCENE 1: New Territory

CHARACTERS: Princess, Shawn, Duke, Chewie, Obi & 3D

(This scene takes place at the cockpit of the Falcon and the forest Bunker. —The Falcon is coming in for a landing at the bunker bay.)

INTRO - CRAWLER VIDEO: music from this video will continue to play as the ACT begins. the music will fade out on its own. This will contain the sound effects of the Falcon landing.

(Everybody is in the Falcon cockpit)

SHAWN: OK, looks like we made it guys!

CHEWIE: (Happy roar)

DUKE: I have to say Han, that was some awesome display of pilot skills, especially through the asteroid field. I bet I could do just as good though!

SHAWN: Don't get cocky, kid! You're old man has lead us to a place we've never been and it don't see a welcome party.

OBI: Don't worry, you will be alright. All of you will stay here, I will go first and signal for you when the all is good.

DUKE: Sooooo, that sounds as if there may be danger lurking out here... I've got a bad feeling about this. I was really hoping that I may get to see my sister for the first time... guess that won't happen in a place like this.

3D: Sir, the possibility of successfully surviving this planet is approximately 3,720 to 1....

SHAWN: Never tell me the odds! (gets blaster in hand) Chewie get your blaster ready. I didn't bargain for this kind of action but here we are.

CHEWIE: roar (gets blaster)

OBI: Put your weapons away! The Lord has not given us a spirit of fear but of peace and a sound mind. The Lord is guiding us, have faith in Him.

DUKE: Yeah, Han, have some faith in God. That can't hurt any.

SHAWN: (doubtful) Yeah.... whatever.

OBI: Duke, you never know what good things lie before you ... be ready!

In the video, you do not see the 'cockpit scene' but you will hear it. Consider altering this portion that suits you best or consider making a small cockpit prop off to the side.
