How To Use This Curriculum

Songs: This curriculum includes 76 different songs. They are divided into opening, lesson and closing sessions. The songs are provided in two different formats. One is just the songs listed on letter size paper. The other is the songs on a 4" x 6" format that can be printed, cut, and laminated if desired to create an easy flipbook for the teacher. Photos of how to create these books are on page 67.

<u>Visual aids for the Teacher</u>: A list of visual aids used for this curriculum is on pages 3 & 4. Photos and instructions are also included an are on pages 64 - 70.

<u>Bibles:</u> I am often surprised at the absence of a Bible in the hands of a teacher in preschool classes. Even if you use it for part of the class period you are reinforcing the source of the story and making the Bible real. I am also an advocate of a small Bible for each child. The Noah/animals clipart to insert into Bibles on pages 6 & 7 is to help a non-reading child identify that the story comes from the Bible.

<u>Cabinet or Storage:</u> A well-organized cabinet can improve the quality of teaching and create a more welcome environment for the teacher and children.

<u>Time Management</u>: This curriculum takes 35—45 minutes depending on how many children are in your class.

Snacks: A well-timed snack such as an animal cracker can immediately bring a class back in control if needed. *Note: Before you use any snack, please be aware of food allergies.*

<u>Disinfecting Toys and the Teaching Surface</u>: There are a lot of different concepts for cleaning toys. However, with the awareness of the complications of long-term effects that chemical cleansers can cause young children, I recommend that every church strive to have a "chemical free" nursery and use only "green" disinfectants or simply soap and hot water
