

NOTE TO TEACHERS (TEE-churz)

Note to teachers... you know who you are.

Daily Readings: Get a book for each student. The chapters are about 12 pages long. Strongly encourage your kids to read a couple of pages a day with breakfast. **Black Boxes:** These questions occur during the flow of the chapter. The answers are often obvious, but it helps springboard class discussion to get tweens' marvelous brains thinking. **Q&A**: Have the kids pencil in their answers. Then check the first appendix for what I thought the answers were. Use this section as a catechism. Activities: Suggestions for full-contact learning: some of us prefer kinetic discovery. Going Deeper: Some of your kids will be challenged enough by what's in the chapters, but some will want to dig down deeper. Send them to Appendix 4 and ask them to take notes on what they find to share with the class. And there are extra sections on the Canon, misuses, translation and a cool page of "Quick Facts."

Since trying to read the Bible without Jesus is like reading someone else's mail, you may need to take care of some business.



"Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.." Luke 4:4, WEB

The Bible can't be beat, and I mean that literally. It has survived the most horrific assaults of any book in history.

The Roman emperor Diocletian in 303 A.D. issued an order to destroy Christians and their sacred book. Who got destroyed? Diocletian. Have you heard of him? No? It's funny, but, within a few years, Diocletian's throne was occupied by the Roman Emperor Constantine, a Christian convert.

Can anyone know for sure what's good, bad, right, wrong, up or down ? Hmmm.

To grant the Bible authority to speak about our lives is only **reasonable**.


WHAT'S THE NAME OF THE THEORY THAT SAYS WE ALL CAME FROM EXPLODING HYDROGEN GAS AND AIR-BREATHING FISH? SOME PEOPLE TRUST THAT THEORY MORE THAN THEY BELIEVE GOD'S WORD, HMMM, I WONDER WHICH IS MORE REASONABLE?

Since God says that we're his children, isn't it reasonable to think he'd want to talk to us, that he'd want us to know him? Good news! He has spoken to us in many ways, especially in the Scriptures, the second best revelation of himself. (The best revelation is of course his Son, Jesus Christ.) He wants to speak to you every day from the pages of your Bible.

Do a lot of people seem to believe the Bible is authoritative, that it speaks to everyone, everywhere, throughout the ages? The answer appears to be a slam-dunk "yes!"

The Bible has been translated into more languages by far than any other book. The number as of 2002 was a staggering 3,000!



Countless people have given up jobs,

homes, families, and their very lives rather than turn their back on the Bible. Christians through history, given the option of death or giving up Biblical truth, choose death.

For a mere book? Or for the holy revelation of the Almighty God? Which do you think?

Does the Bible itself tell us it is the last word on truth? Or have we made the Bible into something it doesn't even claim to be? Hmmm, again. Let's see...

Truth must come from a **reliable source**. A liar will not be believed even when telling the truth. Someone with a reputation for telling the truth will be believed even when what they're saying sounds unbelievable.

If you won't rely on Scripture for truth, then what source would you turn to? Do you trust new ideas simply because they're new? Do you trust your feelings that go up and down by the minute? Do you trust your own brilliance which has embarrassed you time and time again? Do you trust your pop culture heroes who are beautiful buffoons? Horoscopes you could write yourself? Science which changes every few years? Clever people who make crazy wild guesses sound so wonderful? What's your source?

How do we know we've got the real stuff? Where do we find **authoritative truth**? It must come from an **authoritative source**.

MATTHEW 7:24 JESUS SAID, "ANYONE WHO LISTENS TO MY TEACHING AND OBEYS ME IS WISE, LIKE A PERSON WHO BUILDS A HOUSE ON SOLID ROCK. 25 THOUGH THE RAIN COMES IN TORRENTS AND THE FLOODWATERS RISE AND THE WINDS BEAT AGAINST THAT HOUSE, IT WON'T COLLAPSE, BECAUSE IT IS BUILT ON ROCK. 26 BUT ANYONE WHO HEARS MY TEACHING AND IGNORES IT IS FOOLISH, LIKE A PERSON WHO BUILDS A HOUSE ON SAND. 27 WHEN THE RAINS AND FLOODS COME AND THE WINDS BEAT AGAINST THAT HOUSE, IT WILL FALL WITH A MIGHTY CRASH." (NLT)

A funny thing about **eyewitnesses** is that they rarely agree completely about what they saw. How hard is it to agree with <u>one</u> other person on <u>every</u>thing? Impossible! How about three people agreeing? Five? Ten?

The thing is, the Bible was written by **40 people**! And miraculously, they're all in agreement. They wrote at different times and places: over **1500 years** and **three different continents.** They came from different social classes and walks of life. Moses was a prince, Paul a tent maker, Luke a doctor, Amos a shepherd, Peter a commercial fisherman, David and Solomon were kings, Mark an interpreter, Daniel a high government official, and Matthew was with the Internal Revenue Service.

There is no other book ever written that is remotely like the Bible. Such harmony from such diversity! It stands alone.

If God really wrote the Bible, then it should be the all-time best-seller in the history of the world. Well

whadda-ya know? IT IS. If God wrote the Bible, it should answer the deepest questions we could ask. Can you keep a secret? IT DOES. If God wrote the Bible, it should be far and away the most important



book ever written in the world. Guess what? IT ABSOLUTELY IS.

Hello. Are you paying attention?

God must be a grand master at using words, because he's made a lot of things plain in the Bible. Second only to Jesus himself, there's no clearer picture of our Creator's heart and mind. The Bible speaks with authority and finality to the desperation of the human condition, the yearning of the human soul, and the deepest cry of the human heart.
