Strongly encourage your kids to read a couple of pages a day with breakfast. **Black Boxes:** These questions occur during the flow of the chapter. The answers are often obvious, but it helps springboard class discussion to get tweens' marvelous brains thinking. **Q&A**: Have the kids pencil in their answers. Then check the first appendix for what I thought the answers were. Use this section as a catechism. Activities: Suggestions for full-contact learning: some of us prefer kinetic discovery. Going Deeper: Some of your kids will be challenged enough by what's in the chapters, but some will want to dig down deeper. Send them to Appendix 4 and ask them to take notes on what they find to share with the class. The format is free form back there-it's just a treasure trove of ideas with no ties to a specific chapter.

OK, SO IS THIS VERSE SAYING THAT GOD GOT EVERYTHING STARTED AND THEN LEFT, AND THE WORLD KIND OF TOOK OVER THE REST OF THE CREATION PROCESS FROM THERE?

This is one of the most powerful verses in all the Bible. To be a Christian and to blow past these words is shallow and careless. Speaking of the Word of God, John says that all things, **positively all things, were created by the Word of God**, Jesus. If there is a system of thinking that says something other than this, there are two options: either IT is a lie, or the Word of God is. The choice must be faced and the choice must be made. Have you had these thoughts before? INTRODUCTION (in-trow-DUCK-shun)

If I make a drawing, who owns the drawing? If I write a poem, who owns the poem? If I make a sculpture, who owns that sculpture? If I made the world (and believe me, I didn't!), who would own the world?

This book is about what happens to us when we discover that God is our Creator. Once we understand that, once it takes hold of our thinking and understanding, it will shake up our lives. You're human. What does that mean? What is the **essence** of humanity? I suggest it's **curiosity**. Yes cats are curious, in every sense of that word, but

they don't care about how to make Portland cement or why the moon revolves around the earth. But you and I wonder about that.

Your personal curiosity may have been short circuited by our hyper entertain-me society. When I was growing up, my favorite toy was dirt. Tomorrow, as I write this book, people will line up to purchase a coupon to let them line up to buy a Playstation. Something has changed. It has affected **our capacity for being curious** about the world around us.

Curiosity is where it all begins. Your life will be one boring day after another boring day until you learn this wonderful tool.

Look at the wall. See the light switch? What does it do? How does it do that? Who installed it? Who invented it? Why is it next to the door? Where does it's power come from?

How is the power stored and how does it get to this room? Are you getting the idea?!! Leaf through an encyclopedia or walk down the nonfiction aisles of your local library and read the titles. Make you curious?

There's no such thing as a great answer without there being a **great question**. If I say "Sixty six," that answer means nothing until you know that the question is, "How many books are there in the Bible?"

DO YOU HAVE A SENSE OF WONDER? WHAT DO YOU WONDER ABOUT? DO YOU LOOK UP AT THE NIGHT SKY OR WATCH A WORM CRAWL OR SEE A BABY SMILE AND BEGIN TO WONDER WHY THIS WORLD IS THE WAY THIS WORLD IS?

Questions are the beginning of a life of wonder. If you decide to let someone else think for you, they will. But if you decide you're going to look at the cosmos through wondering eyes, you will be rewarded.

WHO am I? **WHAT** am I? And by far the most fascinating, **WHY** am I?



Science itself began with curious Christians. Roger Bacon, a Christian, invented the scientific method later perfected by Francis Bacon: observe, theorize and experimentally test. You want more people who had faith in their Creator? Faraday, Joule, Kepler, Cuvier, Carver, Edison, Einstein, Pascal, Von Braun, Dalton, Morse, Newton, Kelvin, Pasteur, Mendel ... all believers in God and God's creation, who looked for God's fingerprints, all outstanding scientist who had a passionate **curiosity**.

If anyone tries to tell you that science can't include faith, tell them Creationists began science. It's not very bright to claim an open, enlightened mind if God's not allowed in it!



feels about the mysteries of His creation.

The truth is, it's wrong if we don't see God's majesty revealed in creation! In Psalm 8, David says something like, "When I look at the heavens and all that you created, what is man that you should even think of him?" David noticed God's handiwork. **God is actually angry** with those who won't acknowledge Him from creation...

"Destruction is certain for those who argue with their Creator. Does a clay pot ever argue with its maker? How terrible it would be if a newborn baby said to its father and mother, 'Why was I born? Why did you make me this way?'" This is what the LORD, the Creator and

Holy One of Israel, says: 'Do you question what I do? Do you give me orders about the work of my hands? I am the one who made the earth and created people to live on it. With my hands I stretched out the heavens. All the millions of stars are at my command.'" Isaiah 45:9-12 NLT

Those who say that creation is only a fairy tale should read Scriptures like that last one carefully. Those who think themselves so smart that they can confidently claim God did not create the world are in for a rude awakening when they see God face to face and he asks them why they "argued with their Creator." And when you hear someone making fun of creation, tell them God says there's **no excuse for not knowing** about creation, that God will "destroy" those who argue about such obvious truths.

"But God shows his anger from heaven against all... who push the truth away from themselves. From the time the world was created, people have seen the earth and sky and all that God made. They can clearly see his invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature. So they have no excuse whatsoever..." (Romans 1:18-20 NIV)

Should Christians be scientists? What?!! Absolutely!!! Christians should be in touch with their world

in every way possible: artistic, cultural, political, philosophical, and scientific to name a few ways. By all means, if you love botany and biology and physics and astronomy, plunge in. But know that



as a Christian in today's scientific community you'll be an outcast. No different than anywhere else, but just don't be surprised. Jesus said, "If the world hated me, it will hate you too!" What an honor to be in the company of Jesus!

We have now begun to explore the joy of curiosity. We've said that **curiosity is the essence of being human**. We've said that it is the starting place for a life that can't wait for each new day. We've said that science owes it's beginning to those who wanted to find God's fingerprints in creation.

SO THE OUESTION IS NOT WHETHER CHRISTIANS OUGHT TO BE CURIOUS ABOUT THEIR WORLD, THE ONLY OUESTION IS; WHICH PART OF GOD'S CREATION WILL YOU CHOOSE TO INVESTIGATE? HOW ABOUT IT?
