Overview:

Its recruitment time at the H.E.R.O. Headquarters. They are looking for new superheroes who will realize who they've been created to be. They want to help two new recruits stop wearing their disguises and start living by God's power. The opening will have a few ridiculous super heroes walking in and auditioning for the part, before the two main characters enter. It will be a lot of fun to use various leaders in outrageous costumes for these small parts.

Characters:

Mr. X: Appears only on Video and you never see his face. He is the big cheese of H.E.R.O. Headquarters. Live characters will interact with Mr. X. These videos are on the DVD and should be rehearsed well to get the timing down.

Ali Mode: Mr. X's right hand gal. She helps Mr. X carry out his training. Costume idea might be to have her wear all black, or something futuristic.

Gavin and Hunter: Two regular guys who sign up for the H.E.R.O. Headquarters not quite sure what they are getting into. They learn along the way what it means to be a true hero.

Plunger Man: A cape, a mask and a plunger is all he needs. The more ridiculous looking the better.

Tin Foil Man: Wrap someone up in tin foil for this costume. The shinier the better.

The Packager: Make pants and a cape out of bubble wrap packaging rolls. Also a box taper would be good.

Scene opens as Ali Mode enters with a huge stack of office folders and books. On her way to the desk she begins dialogue about the HERO training starting today.

Ali: I can't believe it, HERO training starts to day and we've got a line of crazy people waiting to audition to be a super hero! I wonder what kind of looney toon characters we'll have today. Couldn't be worse than last years bunch of coconuts... (Interrupted by the video of Mr. X)

Mr. X: Good morning Ali Mode, I trust you are ready to find our next batch of heroes?

Ali: Yes Mr. X As always it is my honor to serve here at H.E.R.O Headquarters.
