Overview

The Bible story comes from 1 Samuel 16 as David learns responsibility by caring for sheep. The theological truth taught in this lesson is "I have a conscience and God wants to use it to help me develop into a hero." The Hero Power Words are, "I am eager to do what's right." The Bible verse is, "In all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us." — Romans 8:37. The main idea of this lesson is that children learn to be heroes in the small stuff everyday by looking for things that need to be done and doing them.
