What are the weaknesses of your ministry right now?

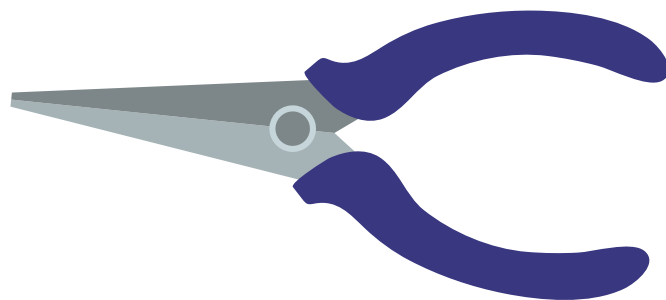
How would you describe the mood of your volunteers right now?
