Needed: Slips of paper and pens/pencils.

How to Play: Everyone writes some good news on a piece of paper with their name. Make it something silly or amazing but not true. (Ex: "12-Year-Old Boy wins presidential election") Pass all the slips to one person, who reads them all without the name. Everyone tries to guess who wrote it. If you guess correctly, you get a point. If someone doesn't guess yours, you get a point. Take turns who reads the news. Play several rounds. Then talk about why you wrote what you did.

After the game, everyone shares some real good news from their life! The Good News of Jesus might seem too good to be true, but it is true!


Think about It

You've probably heard the phrase, "The Gospel of Jesus Christ". Have you ever wondered what the word Gospel means? It's from a Greek word that means "Good News"! But what makes the Good News of Jesus good? You can't have good news without some bad news, or it would just be news! The bad news is that everyone has disobeyed their creator and done bad things. The Bible calls those bad things "sin". It also tells us that the penalty for sin is death — eternal separation from God. That's some pretty bad news! That's where the Good News comes in! The Good News is that God loved us so much that He sent His Son, Jesus, to die in our place — to pay that penalty for us! Anyone who accepts Jesus as their Savior is forgiven! This is really GOOD NEWS!

Make it count!

The most important question you will ever answer your entire life is, "What have you done with Jesus Christ?" Have you accepted Jesus as your Savior or have you rejected the gift of salvation He offers? If you aren't sure, you can make sure TODAY! Why wait? 2 Corinthians 6:2 says, "Indeed, the 'right time' is now. Today is the day of salvation."

You can ask Jesus to save you with a simple prayer, like this: Dear Jesus, I know that I am a sinner. I believe You died for me on the cross to take away my sin. Please forgive my sin. I ask You to come into my life so I can have a relationship with You forever in heaven. I accept Your gift of salvation. Thank you for forgiving me. In Jesus Name, Amen.
